

and building the relevant skills of the potential users





The **Application Process**





Develop Your Full Application







Three sections:

- 1. Tell Us About Yourself
- 2. What's Your Experience and Motivation
- 3. What's the Purpose of Your Fellowship

Once you make the submission, you cannot change your Concept Note. But, before submission, you can log-in as many times as you like to work on your application

Is Your Fellowship Concept Really A Good Idea???

Make sure the purpose of your Fellowship fits the priority themes and types of action Is your proposed Fellowship needed? What difference will it make? Who will benefit? How will they benefit?

NB. For this 'Call', applications may attract additional evaluation scoring for contributing to the **improvement of CSO accountability and linkage to constituencies**







Is Your Concept Eligible???

Have you uploaded your CV? Is the proposed purpose of your fellowship broadly in line with your experience and stated motivations

Have you completed every section of the Form in full? And completed all in English??

Evaluation of Concept Notes

Common Reasons for Failure



- 1. Non-Eligibility
- 2. Unclear or unrealistic purpose
- 3. Applicant demonstrates little or no experience related to the proposed purpose
- 4. Proposed beneficiaries are too vague or general

From the last 'call' 196 Concept Notes were submitted, but only 46 selected for Full Application stage







From Concept Note To Full Application

- 1. Successful Concept Note applicants will be informed of their selection by email and **provided with an online link** to open a Full Application
- During the Incubation Period (August-Oct 2023) you will be working on your Full Application including:
 - Designing a set of activities which will achieve your Fellowship objective and include a list of concrete outputs, along with a proposed budget
 - Uploading all supporting documents (passport, nomination and/or other reference letters, EN proof)!

Use the **Incubation Period** to develop your Fellowship project

Questions about eligibility

- Is there an age limit?

- Can I complete a Concept Note form 'offline' and submit?

- Do I need to submit supporting documents with my Concept Note?
- What happens after the Concept Note?
- If my Concept Note is not selected, can I delete my registration and start again?
